Area - 2,724,900 km² (9th)


Capital – Astana

Republic of Kazakhstan is divided into 14 regions and 2 cities of republican meaning


Government – Unitary dominantparty presidential republic








Biodiversity Expenditure Review for the period 2008 - 2014









Estimated cost for implementation of NBSAP by strategies








